WHEREAS, AMWUA has been engaged in many of Arizona's water milestones, including the passage of the 1980 Groundwater Management Act, the development of the Underground Water Storage and Recovery Act, the establishment of the Arizona Water Banking Authority, the modification of Roosevelt Dam to increase storage capacity of Roosevelt Lake, the 2012 Colorado River Basin Water Supply and Demand Study, and support for the Lower Basin Drought Contingency Plan; and WHEREAS, one of AMWUA's ongoing contributions has been to develop a water conservation ethic in the Phoenix metropolitan area that has reduced per capita demand in the AMWUA municipalities even with a growing population; and

WHEREAS, AMWUA continues to play a significant role guaranteeing the economic success and way of life of the Valley of the Sun.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Douglas A. Ducey, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby congratulate AMWUA on the occasion of its 50th Anniversary and wish it continued success in the future.
